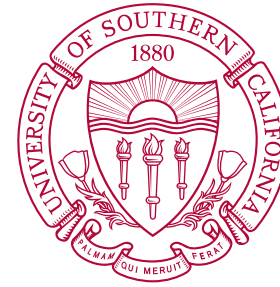

■ Course Objectives

The purpose of this course is to provide physicians and other healthcare providers with a 2 day training experience that exposes them to the essentials of trauma and critical care, and teaches requisite critical care procedural skills.

The sessions will consist of educational activities and rounds with the trauma/critical care team and small group sessions in the Surgical Skills Training and Education Center, where participants will learn and practice each skill.
